## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Directly correspond with clients via phone, email, and in-person
- Provide in-person client care when checking in for a session or appointment
- Notify staff when client or patient arrives
- Notify staff when a client or patient has a question or message for the provider
- Email staff members regarding specific client inquiries for those with soft holds or managing their own calendar
- Manage the stock of office supplies (stationary, kitchen, bathroom, etc) and notify HR Director when supplies are running low
- Re-direct IOP inquiries and questions to Clinical Director or Clinical Programming Case Manager
- Assist staff with administrative tasks when not interacting with clients on the phone or in person
